Dr. Duk-Hee Lee is a professor in the Department of Preventive Medicine, School of Medicine, Kyungpook National University in Daegu, South Korea. She holds a MD and PhD in preventive medicine. As an epidemiologist, her research area is health effects of low dose chemical mixtures, especially persistent organic pollutants (POPs), in human. In particular, her publications have suggested that lipophilic chemicals like POPs accumulated in adipose tissue may play a more important role in the pathogenesis of obesity-related health problems rather than obesity itself. She has published more than 170 research articles in peer-reviewed international journals. She served as Associated Editor of Environment International and is serving as an editorial member of Environmental Research, Current Environmental Health Reports, and Journal of Epidemiology and Community Health.
